## Tall Ships & Waterfront Festival in Hampton Roads

June 18-21, 2026

### Day 1 – Thursday, June 18, 2026 ~ Maritime Heritage & Harbor Adventures

Travel south to Virginia's storied coastline and begin your journey with a guided visit to the renowned Mariners' Museum, one of the largest maritime museums in the nation, where priceless artifacts bring centuries of seafaring history to life. After lunch, cruise the scenic waterways aboard the Hampton Queen on a narrated harbor tour covering more than 400 years of history complete with sweeping views and possible dolphin sightings. Cap off the day with a nostalgic ride on the beautifully restored 1920 Hampton Carousel, followed by a delicious seafood dinner at Chesapeake Bay culinary institution. Settle in for the night at your comfy hotel.

### Day 2 – Friday, June 19, 2026 ~ Tall Ships & Fort Monroe – America's Maritime Story Unfolds

After breakfast, take your seats along the waterfront at Fort Monroe for the unforgettable SAIL250® Tall Ship Parade, as majestic sailing vessels glide into Hampton Roads in honor of America's 250th anniversary. Enjoy lunch overlooking the water before returning to Fort Monroe for tour of this historic stronghold, which has played a role in many defining moments of American history. Travel onward to Virginia Beach for an abundant seafood buffet dinner, then check into your oceanfront resort for a relaxing evening by the Atlantic.

### Day 3 – Saturday, June 20, 2026 ~ Norfolk's Sail250® Festival & Fireworks on the Waterfront

Head into Norfolk to explore Nauticus and tour the mighty USS Wisconsin, followed by visits aboard docked SAIL250® tall ships. Enjoy free time along the lively waterfront festival, with lunch on your own and the flexibility of an all-day ferry pass for water-level views and optional exploration of historic Portsmouth. This evening, dine on the water at a scenic marina restaurant, offering prime views of the harbor—then enjoy a spectacular fireworks display, perfectly concluding a day immersed in maritime celebration.
